

All members of the PLCC shall be bound by this Code of Conduct.

Members have a right to:

- 1 Be treated fairly, equally and with respect by the PLCC, its Committee and other members.
- 2 Socialise in an environment free from all forms of harassment and discrimination.
- 3 Privacy and confidentiality concerning records, documentation and any other communication containing a member's personal information, unless consent is otherwise provided.
- 4 Be informed and actively involved in all club events and offerings.
- 5 Voice their opinions, requirements and suggestions to the Committee.

Members must:

- 1 Treat other members, guests, staff of venues and other patrons (where a social club function is being held) fairly, equally and with respect and courtesy.
- 2 Behave responsibly and ensure they conduct themselves in a manner which will not injure the reputation of PLCC, its events, organisers, participants or sponsors.
- 3 Not physically or verbally harass others.
- 4 Report any inappropriate behaviour of a member to the Committee of PLCC for action and follow up.
- 5 Abide by and uphold the Constitution and Code of Conduct.

Breaches of this Code of Conduct:

- 1 The inappropriate behaviour of any members will be investigated, discussed and an appropriate course of action will be taken by the Committee, which may include a reprimand, suspension or revocation of membership in accordance with the grievance and disciplinary procedures set out in the PLCC rules.
